Chaining/Tethering

Tethering is the practice of fastening a dog to a stationary object or stake, usually in the owner's backyard, for days, months and even years. L.A.W. seeks to eliminate the chaining or tethering of pets through education and the provision of alternate means of confinement.



Tethering a dog restricts movement, most often resulting in a poorly adjusted animal.
